RESOLUTION NO. 67-3

AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF THE DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY
TO REVIEW AND APPROVE CONSTRUCTION PLANS
FOR THE PURPOSE OF PUBLIC LAW 660, 84TH CONGRESS

WHEREAS, for the purposes of Public Law 660, 84th Congress (33 U.S.C. 466 et seq.), the Federal Water Pollution Control Administration requires that the state water pollution control agency review and approve the final construction plans and specifications of applicants for federal grants under Section 8 of said law; and

WHEREAS, by Chapter 1666, Statutes of 1967, the Legislature designated the State Water Resources Control Board as "the appropriate state water pollution control agency" authorized to represent the State of California and its local governmental agencies and subdivisions in participating in federal assistance for sewage treatment facilities, and provided for review, approval, and certification of priority of projects for which federal assistance is requested;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chief of the Division of Water Quality of this Board is hereby authorized to review and approve said plans and specifications for the purposes of said Public Law 660; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in reviewing and approving said plans and specifications, the Chief of the Division of Water Quality shall be guided by, but not necessarily limited to, the following considerations:

1. Statements submitted by the applicant in accordance with the Board's regulations for certifying priority and approval of projects eligible for federal construction grants under Public Law 660, said regulations being Subchapter 7, Chapter 3, Title 23, of the California Administrative Code.
2. Engineering design criteria used by the Southwest Regional Office of the Federal Water Pollution Control Administration in reviewing and approving said plans and specifications.
3. Engineering design criteria used by the California State Department of Public Health as set forth in the May, 1946, outline titled "Ordinary Bases of Sanitary Loadings Used by Bureau of Sanitary Engineering in Appraising Sewage Disposal Projects."
