AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF THE DIVISION OF WATER QUALITY
TO REVIEW AND APPROVE APPLICATIONS FOR FEDERAL
DEMONSTRATION GRANTS UNDER PROVISIONS OF THE
FEDERAL WATER POLLUTION CONTROL ACT


WHEREAS, for the purposes of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C. 466 et seq.), the Secretary of the Interior and the appropriate state water pollution control agency must review and approve applications before a federal demonstration grant may be made to any state, municipality, or intermunicipal or interstate agency for research and development projects to demonstrate (a) new or improved methods of controlling discharge of sewage or other wastes from sewers carrying storm water or combined storm water and sewage or other wastes; or (b) advanced waste treatment and water purification methods, or new or improved methods of joint treatment systems for municipal and other wastes;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chief of the Division of Water Quality of this Board is hereby authorized to review and approve said applications for demonstration grants for the purpose of said Federal Water Pollution Control Act.
