RESOLUTION IMPLEMENTING PROVISIONS OF CALIFORNIA
ADMINISTRATIVE CODE RELATING TO LICENSING AND
REGULATION OF USE OF OIL SPILL CLEANUP AGENTS


WHEREAS, regulations to license and regulate the use of oil spill cleanup agents were adopted by the State Water Resources Control Board on January 8, 1970, and

WHEREAS, Section 2320 of Article 2 and Sections 2331 and 2334 of Article 3 of Subchapter 10, Chapter 3, Title 23, of the California Administrative Code state that the Board or its designee in the event of an emergency may approve and authorize the use of an oil spill cleanup agent in any waters of the State,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board designates the Executive Officer or his designee to be responsible for implementation and administration of the above Sections 2320, 2331 and 2334 in the absence of Board action pursuant to these sections.
