AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE
AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH
TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF
WASTE DISPOSAL METHODS IN MOUNTAIN AREAS


WHEREAS, The State Department of Public Health has submitted a proposal to conduct a study of waste disposal in mountain areas; and

WHEREAS, The information is needed by the State Board for preparation of a water quality control plan for mountain areas as required by the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board hereby authorizes the Executive Officer to execute an agreement between the State Department of Public Health and the State Water Resources Control Board in the amount of \$3,000 for study of mountain area waste disposal practices. The work to be completed and the final report transmitted to the State Board not later than October 5, 1970.
