AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE  
AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES  
CONTROL BOARD AND THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC  
HEALTH FOR ASSISTANCE IN PREPARATION  
OF INTERIM WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLANS

WHEREAS, the State Board is preparing statewide interim water quality management plans in accordance with the Water Pollution Control Act, 33 U.S.C. Ch. 23 and the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act, Water Code, Division 7, and

WHEREAS, the scope of the planning requires input relative to existing water quality; wastewater reclamation; beneficial water uses; water quality objectives; evaluation of water quality management plans; water supply; and other input, and


WHEREAS, the Department of Public Health indicates that District personnel can provide this input to the Board on a contractual basis, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that this Board authorize the Executive Officer to execute an agreement with the Department of Public Health for assistance in the preparation of statewide water quality management plans, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the agreement between the State Board and the Department of Public Health shall be applicable for the period of approximately February 1, 1971, through June 30, 1971, and shall not exceed an amount of \$8,000.
