STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 71-18

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR CHIEF, DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION FOR ASSISTANCE IN PREPARATION OF WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLANS

WHEREAS, the State Board is preparing statewide fully developed water quality control plans in accordance with the Water Pollution Control Act, 33 U.S.C. Ch. 23 and the Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act, Water Code, Division 7, and

WHEREAS, the scope of the planning requires input relative to mine pollution and control, watershed and vegetative conditions as they relate to sediment production, the effects on water quality of urbanization and forest practices, and the identification of water quality problems from oil, gas and geothermal development, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Conservation indicates that selected personnel can provide this input to the Board on a contractual basis, therefore be it

RESOLVED, that this Board authorized the Executive Officer or Chief, Division of Administrative Services, to execute an agreement with the State Department of Conservation for assistance in the preparation of statewide quality control plans, and be it further

RESOLVED, that the agreement between the State Board and the Department of Conservation shall be applicable for the period of approximately July 1, 1971, through June 30, 1973, and shall not exceed an amount of \$200,000.
