TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS BETWEEN  
THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND  
THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AND  
THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME  
FOR ASSISTANCE IN REVIEWING  
OIL SPILL CLEANUP AGENT APPLICATIONS

WHEREAS, the State Board previously adopted regulations for  
licensing of oil spill cleanup agents, and


WHEREAS, both the Departments of Fish and Game and Public  
Health have personnel and laboratory facilities qualified  
to verify data necessary to evaluate oil spill cleanup agents;  
now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that this Board authorize the Chief of the Division  
of Administrative Services to execute agreements with the  
State Department of Public Health and the State Department  
of Fish and Game to assist in reviewing applications and  
verifying data relative to the licensing of oil spill cleanup  
agents, and be it further

RESOLVED, that each agreement shall be applicable without  
regard to fiscal year and each agreement shall not exceed  
an amount of \$10,000.
