SAN MARCOS COUNTY WATER DISTRICT FOR USE OF THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT AS A TRAINING FACILITY

WHEREAS, the Water Quality Office of the Environmental Protection Agency has provided the State Water Resources Control Board with a grant for training wastewater treatment plant operators in an annual amount of approximately \$110,000; and

WHEREAS, the training facility will be at the wastewater plant in San Marcos; and

WHEREAS, the plant is abandoned for day-by-day use but is still under ownership of the San Marcos County Water District; and

WHEREAS, the State Board plans to utilize the plant as a training facility; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that this Board authorize the Chief, Division of Administrative Services, to execute an agreement for the use of the wastewater treatment plant as a training facility.
