

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 72-10

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR CHIEF, DIVISION OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF DAIRY SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL

WHEREAS:

1. The pollution from animal manure has been identified as a significant problem to water quality.
2. Completely satisfactory methods of manure disposal have not yet been developed.
3. These wastes are more concentrated and contain more fiber than human wastes. Therefore, they are not amenable to the same treatment processes.
4. On August 19, 1971, the Board authorized a \$15,000 study of the methods of disposal of animal manures in the Chino Valley. The dairy industry has agreed to support half of the project.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Board enter into an agreement with the University of California for the conduct of this study during the period March 2, 1972, through June 30, 1973, at a cost not to exceed \$7,500 of Clean Water Bond funds.
2. That the Board's Executive Officer or Chief, Division of Administrative Services, is authorized to execute the agreement on behalf of the Board.
