AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES OFFICER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES FOR THE PREPARATION OF A FEASIBILITY STUDY AND IMPLEMENTATION PLAN FOR THE BOARD'S INFORMATION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

WHEREAS:

- Pursuant to Section 13166 of the California Water Code, the State Water Resources Control Board is authorized to prepare and implement a statewide water quality information storage and retrieval program.
- 2. The Board believes that said Information Management Program should be automated.
- The Department of Finance must approve a Feasibility Study and Implementation Plan for automated data systems.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. This Board authorizes the Executive Officer or the Administrative Services Officer to execute an agreement with the Department of General Services to prepare a Feasibility Study and Implementation Plan for the Board's Information Management System in accordance with Section 4800 of the State Administrative Manual at a cost to the Board not to exceed \$9.700.
