RESOLUTION NO. 74-63

AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT  
WITH U. S. DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE,  
SOIL CONSERVATION SERVICE, FOR AN  
INTERGOVERNMENTAL PERSONNEL ASSIGNMENT

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board has increased activities in regulation and planning for water quality control in irrigated agriculture.
2. The U. S. Department of Agriculture, Soil Conservation Service, has ongoing programs of assistance to conservation districts involved with irrigated agriculture.
3. The State Board and the Soil Conservation Service will both benefit by having an experienced employee of the Soil Conservation Service work with the State Board staff.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorize the Executive Officer, or any person delegated by the Executive Officer, to execute an agreement with the U. S. Department of Agriculture, Soil Conservation Service, for an Intergovernmental Personnel Assignment for a two-year period with an option to extend for one additional year, in an amount not to exceed \$13,500 per year plus 51% of moving expenses required to relocate the employee at the start and end of the assignment, funded from Clean Water Bond Funds.
