RESOLUTION NO. 75-9

ENDORING A STRATEGY FOR DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF AREAWIDE WASTE TREATMENT MANAGEMENT PLANS-PART I, DESIGNATED AREAS AND AGENCIES, DIRECTING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO IMPLEMENT SAID STRATEGY, AND DELEGATING TO THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER ALL AUTHORITIES IDENTIFIED FOR DELEGATION

WHEREAS:


1. The Governor has delegated to the Board those powers and duties conferred upon the Governor by Section 208 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act Amendments of 1972.
2. Section 208 and regulations issued pursuant thereto provide that the Board shall identify potential areawide waste treatment management planning areas prior to any designation of such areas pursuant to Section 208.
3. Regulations issued by the Environmental Protection Agency regarding grant assistance for areawide waste treatment management planning under Section 208 require that, as a part of an application for assistance, a statement of certification or refusal of certification of the application must be submitted by the chief officials of the reviewing agency designated by the Governor.
4. Subchapter 18, Chapter 3, Title 23 of the California Administrative Code requires that agencies designated pursuant to Section 208 enter into an agreement with the Board.
5. The Board has reviewed the proposed Strategy for Development and Implementation of Areawide Waste Treatment Management Plans-Part I, Designated Areas and Agencies, dated February 20, 1975.
6. Orderly and efficient conduct of the business of the Board will be promoted by delegation of authority to the Executive Officer to identify potential areawide waste treatment management planning areas, to execute agreements as specified in Section 2757(b), Subchapter 18, Chapter 3, Title 23, California Administrative Code, and to certify or refuse to certify applications for grant assistance submitted pursuant to Section 208.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Board endorses, and directs the Executive Officer to implement, the Strategy for Development and Implementation of Areawide Waste Treatment Management Plans-Part I, Designated Areas and Agencies, dated February 20, 1975, and hereby delegates to the Executive Officer the following authorities identified for delegation therein:
 - a. Identification of potential 208 planning areas.
 - b. Execution of agreements with designated agencies.
 - c. Certification and approval of 208 grant applications.
 - d. Execution of contracts with each designated agency to cover state cost of administration of each designation.
2. That Resolution No. 74-52 is hereby rescinded.
