

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 75-12

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE BOARD AND THE
DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME FOR PROVIDING
CLASSIFICATION INFORMATION ON SELECTED
LAKES IN CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS:

1. The State Board is required to coordinate the establishment of a statewide surveillance and monitoring program, including the classification of all publicly-owned fresh water lakes.
2. State Board supplemental federal program grant monies are available to perform this task.
3. Various state agencies possess much of the information necessary to complete the lakes classification, but the State lacks an information management system to bring the data together in order to make it readily available.
4. The Department of Fish and Game is willing to summarize the information they possess and to acquire and summarize appropriate information from the Department of Water Resources and water quality control plans on the 1,100 selected lakes in California.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorizes the Executive Officer, or any person delegated by the Executive Officer, to execute an Agreement for the period of one year from the approval date of this Agreement between the State Water Resources Control Board and the Department of Fish and Game in an amount not to exceed \$14,200 of Program Grant Funds for the Department to document existing information necessary to classify the lakes in California.
