RESOLUTION NO. 75-23

PARTICIPATION IN PUBLIC SERVICE EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM

WHEREAS:

1. California has the highest number of unemployed in the nation and one of its highest unemployment rates in several years;
2. Public service employment programs under the Comprehensive Employment and Training Act (CETA) of 1973 were created to provide temporary and permanent employment with special consideration provided to veterans, welfare recipients and severely disadvantaged persons;
3. The Governor has directed all departments to participate in the Public Service Employment programs;
4. The State Personnel Board as coordinator of this program has indicated to the Board that certain of our job proposals will be funded;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorize the Executive Officer, or any person delegated by the Executive Officer, to execute such agreements as are necessary with the State Personnel Board to implement the Public Service Employment and Emergency Jobs Program. The direct personnel costs of this program are not to exceed \$361,260. No direct personnel costs will be incurred by the State Water Resources Control Board.
