

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 75-39

APPROVING RESOLUTIONS NOS. 75-069, 75-070, 75-071, AND 75-072
OF THE CENTRAL VALLEY REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD

WHEREAS:

1. At its March 21, 1975 meeting, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board adopted amendments to the Water Quality Control Plan (Interim), San Joaquin River Basin (5C) and Tulare Lake Basin (5D) which prohibit the discharge of waste from leaching or percolation systems within the following areas:
 - East Porterville Area, Tulare County (Resolution No. 75-069)
 - Coulterville County Service Area No. 1, Mariposa County (Resolution No. 75-070)
 - Kettleman City County Service Area No. 1, Kings County (Resolution No. 75-071)
 - Midway Community Services District, Merced County (Resolution No. 75-072)
2. The discharge prohibitions are reasonable and necessary in view of the documented evidence regarding geologic conditions in the designated areas, the reported failures of subsurface disposal systems, and the reported direct discharge of sewage to ground surface.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board approves Resolutions Nos. 75-069, 75-070, 75-071, and 75-072 of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board amending the Water Quality Control Plan (Interim), San Joaquin River Basin (5C) and Tulare Lake Basin (5D).
