

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 75-48

AUTHORIZING WITHDRAWAL OF PREVIOUS APPROVAL OF
STATE WATER QUALITY CONTROL FUND LOAN
FOR THE ISLA VISTA SANITARY DISTRICT

WHEREAS:

1. The Board on June 12, 1972, approved a loan from the State Water Quality Control Fund in the amount of \$325,000 for the Isla Vista Sanitary District but the District did not go ahead with construction of the specified project as planned and on April 11, 1975, requested a ninety-day extension to make its final decision on proceeding with the project.
2. The monies committed from the Fund for this loan approved almost three years ago could be used for loans for other projects which are nearing readiness for construction, and thereby relieve the need for transfer of monies from the State Clean Water Fund to augment the Loan Fund.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That this Board authorize the Executive Officer or any person delegated by the Executive Officer, to ascertain whether the Isla Vista Sanitary District intends to proceed with the specified project, and if the District does not take positive action by August 1, 1975, to proceed with construction, to notify the District that the previous approval for a loan is withdrawn.
2. That such withdrawal does not preclude consideration of any future new or amended application for a loan corresponding with then current project and financial conditions.
3. That if the District should proceed with the project, this Board authorize the Executive Officer, or any person delegated by the Executive Officer, to adjust the previously approved loan amount to reflect current estimated costs with the loan amount to be set when the Board considers the loan contract.
