RESOLUTION NO. 75-106

PLACING THE CITY OF LODI'S WHITE SLOUGH WASTEWATER
TREATMENT PLANT PROJECT ON THE FISCAL YEAR 1974-75
PRIORITY LIST

WHEREAS:

1. The Five Year Municipal Project List included in the Interim Water Quality Control Plan for Basin 5B listed a project for upgrading and expansion of the Lodi White Slough Wastewater Treatment Plant to be included on the F.Y. 1974-75 Priority List.
2. Lodi was requested by the staffs of the California Regional Water Quality Control Board and the State Water Resources Control Board to accelerate it's project in order to accommodate flows anticipated from an interceptor to be constructed by Woodbridge Sanitary District, which was on the 1972-73 F.Y. Priority List.
3. In response to the State and Regional Board staff requests, Lodi asked the State Board to place its project in order to F.Y. 1973-74 Priority List and the State Board did, in fact, place the project on the earlier Priority List.
4. On June 20, 1974, the State Board amended Section 2133 of it's Regulations (Title 23 California Administrative Code, Chapter 3, Subchapter 7) to provide that where the capacity of treatment works exceeded the capacity limits set forth in Section 2133 allocation between eligible and ineligible costs would be made on an incremental cost basis for F.Y. 1974-75 and later fiscal year projects while maintaining the pro rata funding basis for F.Y. 1973-74 projects.
5. By letter dated June 2, 1975, Lodi requested that incremental funding be provided for it's project on the grounds that the project would have been on the F.Y. 1974-75 Priority List and thus subject to incremental funding for oversizing had Lodi not cooperated with the State and Regional Board staffs in requesting acceleration.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Lodi White Slough Wastewater Treatment Facility project be placed on the F.Y. 1974-75 Priority List and be subject to all regulations applicable to projects on said list.
