APPROVING ORDER NO. 76-215 OF THE CENTRAL VALLEY  
REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD AMENDING THE  
WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN, SACRAMENTO RIVER BASIN (5A)

WHEREAS:


1. At its September 24, 1976, meeting, the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board adopted an amendment to the Water Quality Control Plan, Sacramento River Basin (5A), which (1) prohibits discharge from new leaching and percolation systems within specified portions of the South Lakeshore Assessment District, Lake County, and (2) prohibits any discharge of waste from existing leaching or percolation systems in the designated area after January 1, 1979.
2. This prohibition is reasonable and necessary in light of the evidence regarding the hydrogeologic conditions in the designated area and the threat of contamination of surface waters.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board approve Order No. 76-215 of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board amending the Water Quality Control Plan, Sacramento River Basin (5A).
