

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 79-72

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF
A CONTRACT FOR A STUDY OF "OZONE TREATMENT
OF WASTEWATER USED IN COOLING TOWERS"

WHEREAS:

1. Need exists to develop less costly methods to pretreat and condition water for industrial water recycling.
2. Recent study showed ozonation was effective in preventing biological fouling and permitted operation of cooling waters at very high cycles of concentration.
3. Brown and Caldwell Consulting Engineers propose to further study and evaluate ozone treatment - a possible economic way to pretreat and condition water for industrial water recycling.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Director be authorized to negotiate and execute a contract for a study of "Ozone Treatment of Wastewater Used in Cooling Towers" not to exceed \$98,523.
