

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 83-18
CERTIFYING AMENDMENTS TO THE AREAWIDE
WASTE TREATMENT MANAGEMENT (208) PLAN
FOR THE SAN DIEGO AREA

WHEREAS:

1. The San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG), as the designated 208 planning agency for the San Diego Area, prepared the 1978 Areawide Waste Treatment (208) Plan. The Plan was certified by the State Water Resources Control Board and approved by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.
2. SANDAG has amended its 208 Plan, and has submitted the amendments to the State Water Resources Control Board in accordance with the provisions of 40 CFR 35.1523-2.
3. The State Water Resources Control Board is required by the provisions of 40 CFR 35.1523-3 to evaluate the SANDAG amendments and to certify, or not to certify, them as being in conformance with the evaluation criteria specified in 40 CFR 35.1523-2 and 35.1533-1; and to inform the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency as to its findings.
4. State Board regulations (Section 3636(c)(1)) require that population projections used to determine eligible capacity for 201 planning will be based on population projections approved by the Office of Planning and Research (OPR).
5. The SANDAG Series V Regional Growth Forecasts were approved by OPR, as indicated in their December 9, 1981 letter to SANDAG, for purposes of 208 and air quality planning. For purposes of 201 funding, the EPA-approved Series IV numbers will be used.
6. The State Water Resources Control Board has found the following SANDAG 208 Plan amendments to be in conformance with the criteria for certification:
 - a. Regional Growth Forecasts
 - b. Water Resources Element
 - c. Environmental, Social and Economic Assessment (ESEA)
 - d. Water Supply and Water Conservation
 - e. Agricultural Program
 - f. San Diego Bay Clam Bed Enhancement.


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Board hereby unconditionally certifies the SANDAG 208 Plan Amendments which are specified in WHEREAS Number 6.
2. That certification of the SANDAG Series V Regional Growth forecasts is made with the understanding that the previous Series IV forecasts will be used for purposes of 201 funding.

3. That the Executive Director shall transmit the certified 208 plan amendments to the EPA Region IX, Regional Administrator for approval.
