RESOLUTION NO. 83- 55

RATIFYING AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH SERVICES (DHS) NEGOTIATED BY THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR FOR WORK PERFORMED PURSUANT TO THE FEDERAL RESOURCES CONSERVATION AND RECOVERY ACT (RCRA) DURING FEDERAL F. Y. 1983

WHEREAS:


1. The Department of Health Services (DHS) is the lead state agency for administering RCRA in California, and receives federal grants to carry out that program.
2. For several years it has been anticipated that the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) will perform water quality related tasks required under RCRA, through interagency agreements with DHS.
3. The 1982-83 and 1983-84 State Budgets reflect the intent to execute such an agreement, under which a portion of the federal grant funds would be allocated to the State Water Resources Control Board to perform water quality tasks.
4. On December 31, 1982, the Chairwoman of the Board and the Director of DHS signed a Memorandum of Agreement which defines the tasks to be performed by the SWRCB.
5. On April 14, 1983, the Executive Director signed an interagency agreement for an amount not to exceed \$300,000 reimbursement for performance of said work during the period October 1, 1982 to September 30, 1983.
6. Said agreement reflects the intent of the State Board.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board ratifies the agreement with DHS negotiated and signed by the Executive Director on April 14, 1983 for the performance of RCRA-related tasks during the federal Fiscal Year 1983.
