RESOLUTION NO. 85-3

APPROVAL OF AN ADJUSTMENT OF THE SUSPENDED SOLIDS LIMITATION IN
TABLE A OF THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR OCEAN WATERS OF
CALIFORNIA FOR COUNTY SANITATION DISTRICTS OF ORANGE COUNTY,
NPDES PERMIT NO. CA 0110604

WHEREAS:

1. The 1983 Water Quality Control Plan for Ocean Waters of California (Ocean Plan) allows California Regional Water Quality Control Boards to adjust the lower effluent suspended solids limit of 60 mg/l with the concurrence of the State Board and the U. S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
2. On July 13, 1984, the California Regional Water Quality Control Board, Santa Ana Region, adopted Order No. 84-1 (NPDES No. CA 0110604) for County Sanitation Districts of Orange County (CSDOC).
3. The permit adopted under Order No. 84-1 includes an adjustment of the lower suspended solids limit (60mg/l) to allow CSDOC to discharge at a mass emission rate of 121,000 lbs/day. This mass emission rate reflects a suspended solids concentration slightly above 60 mg/l at the present flow rate.
4. The increase in the suspended solids limitation is based on water reclamation needs and consideration of effect on the ocean environment and should not cause significant adverse environmental impact.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the State Board concurs with the suspended solids limitation contained in Santa Ana Regional Board Order No. 84-1.
2. That the State Board directs the Executive Director to transmit the adjustment to EPA for concurrence.
