RESOLUTION NO. 85- 22

AUTHORIZING NEGOTIATION AND EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO FOR THE SAN DIEGO/TIJUANA BORDER WATER QUALITY PROBLEM

WHEREAS:

1. The State Budget Act of 1984, as amended by AB 3544, appropriated \$5,365,000 for local assistance to construct a treatment facility to handle raw sewage entering the United States from Tijuana.
2. The City of San Diego has made an application for funds needed to plan, design and construct facilities for treatment of wastewater flowing into the United States from Tijuana, Mexico.
3. The Board has determined that the facilities proposed by the applicant are necessary to prevent water pollution.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Executive Director be authorized to negotiate and execute a contract with the City of San Diego for the San Diego/Tijuana border water quality problem in an amount not to exceed \$5,365,000.
