AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES FOR PROGRAMMING SERVICES TO SUPPORT THE BOARD'S DATA MANAGEMENT ACTIVITIES.

WHEREAS:


1. The Approved Automated Water Rights Information System (AWRIS) Budget Change Proposal (BCP) for Fiscal Year 1984-85 requires the Data Management Branch to perform a number of expansions and improvements to the existing Water Rights computerized information system, and
2. The State Board does not have sufficient programming staff to provide support to the AWRIS Enhancements project and it is necessary to contract for this support.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Board authorize the Executive Director to negotiate and execute an Interagency Agreement with the Department of General Services to develop programs for four computer systems in an amount not to exceed \$241,000 through June 30, 1987.
