

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
RESOLUTION NO. 86- 47

APPROVAL TO AWARD SUPPLEMENTAL STATE
GRANT ASSISTANCE TO THE LOS ALAMOS COMMUNITY
SERVICES DISTRICT - PROJECT NO. C-06-1664

WHEREAS:

1. The Los Alamos project received an EPA grant (Step 4) in April 1985 for a total eligible cost of \$1.576 million;
2. In March 1986, the Division of Clean Water Grants approved the final plans and specifications for the project;
3. The Los Alamos Community has a population less than 5,000. Total project costs are estimated to be about \$2.8 million;
4. The Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 provides that for projects costing more than \$2.5 million a finding is made by the Board that the proposed project is the most cost-effective solution to the water quality or public health problem;
5. The State Board's Implementation Plan and Policy for the Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 provides that small, needy communities may receive a supplemental state assistance grant after receiving approval of final plans and specifications;
6. The State Board's Implementation Plan and Policy provides that the amount of supplemental grant be determined by using the formula contained in that document. The above document limits the combined federal and state grant assistance to a maximum of 97.5% of the total eligible costs;
7. The requested supplemental grant will not result in a combined federal and state assistance of more than 97.5% of the project eligible costs.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The State Board has determined that the proposed project is the most cost-effective solution to the water quality problem.
2. The State Board has determined that Los Alamos Community Services District is eligible to receive a supplemental state grant under the 1984 Clean Water Bond Law.
3. The State Board approves the award of state supplemental grant assistance in the amount of \$833,000 to the Los Alamos Community Services District.
