STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 88-9

APPROVAL TO AWARD SUPPLEMENTAL STATE GRANT ASSISTANCE TO THE TENNANT COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT - CLEAN WATER GRANT NO. C-06-2951-110

WHEREAS:

- The Tennant Community Services District project is scheduled to receive an EPA/State grant in February 1988 for a total federal eligible cost of \$335.600; and
- The Division of Clean Water Grants is reviewing the plans and specifications for the project; and
- 3. The Tennant community has a population less than 5,000 and the total eligible project costs are estimated to be under \$2.5 million; and
- 4. The State Board's Implementation Plan and Policy for the Clean Water Bond Law of 1984 provides that communities may receive a supplemental state assistance grant after receiving approval of final plans and specifications; and
- 5. The State Board's Implementation Plan and Policy provides that the amount of the supplemental grant be determined by using the formula contained in that document; and
- 6. The requested supplemental grant will not result in a combined federal and state assistance of more than 97.5 percent of the state eligible project costs.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

- Has determined that Tennant Community Services District is eligible to receive a supplemental state grant under the 1984 Clean Water Bond Law; and
- Approves the award of state supplemental grant assistance in the estimated amount of \$250,000 to the Tennant Community Services District.
