RESOLUTION NO. 88- 129

ADOPTION OF THE FFY 1989 STATE REVOLVING FUND
(SRF) LOAN PROGRAM PRIORITY LIST

WHEREAS:

1. The Division of Loans and Grants has proposed a FFY 1989 SRF Loan Program Priority List based on Regional Board and public input consistent with the federal Clean Water Act.
2. The Clean Water Act allows the states to set aside up to 20 percent of their allotment to fund major sewer system rehabilitation (Needs Category IIIIB), new collector sewers and appurtenances (Needs Category IVA), and combined sewer overflow correction (Needs Category V) projects. The current level of federal funding for this set-aside is not sufficient to meet the needs in these three categories.
3. The Clean Water Act allows delegated states to reserve a portion of their annual allotment for SRF loan administration.
4. Section 601(a) of the Clean Water Act authorizes loan funding for construction of treatment works, for implementing a management program under Section 319, and for developing and implementing a conservation and management plan under Section 320.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

1. Places a \$40 million funding limit on the amount of loan funds that can be received by any single agency and adopts the FFY 1989 SRF Loan Program Priority List.
2. Approves the set-aside of 20 percent of the FFY 1989 allotment for construction of new collector sewers and appurtenances only.
3. Approves the set-aside of four percent of the FFY 1989 Capitalization Grant for SRF loan administration.
4. Directs the staff to prepare a report by March 1, 1989, which addresses the Board's options for using FFY 1990 SRF loan funds to provide assistance for Sections 319 and 320 projects.
