STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION No. 89-10

AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A WATER LABORATORY SERVICES CONTRACT AMENDMENT TO SUPPORT ONGOING REGULATORY AND ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITIES OF THE CALIFORNIA REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD, SAN FRANCISCO BAY REGION (SAN FRANCISCO BAY REGIONAL BOARD)

WHEREAS:

- 1. The San Francisco Bay Regional Board has a continuing need for laboratory analyses of water quality samples taken as part of its regulatory programs.
- 2. The current laboratory services contract with NET Pacific, Inc. does not include laboratory services related to Underground Storage Tanks or AB 1803, Compliance Inspections. An additional \$23,000 has been budgeted to cover these needed services.
- 3. The San Francisco Bay Regional Board wants to increase the current contract with NET Pacific, Inc. from \$87,304 to \$110,304 for water laboratory services related to Underground Storage Tanks and AB 1803, Compliance Inspections.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

That the State Board authorize the Executive Director or his designee to negotiate and execute a water laboratory services contract amendment to support the water quality monitoring activities of the San Francisco Bay Regional Board for an amount not to exceed \$23,000 (contract total \$110,304) for Fiscal Year 1988-89, subject to availability of funds.
