STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 90-52

ADDITION OF THE BIG PINE INDIAN RESERVATION TO THE SMALL COMMUNITY GRANT (SCG) PROGRAM PROJECT PRIORITY LIST

WHEREAS:

- 1. The voters approved the Clean Water and Water Reclamation Bond Law of 1988 which authorizes \$25 million in funds to construct wastewater treatment facilities for small communities;
- At the March 22, 1990 Board Meeting, the Board approved an update to the SCG Program Priority List, including a \$221,000 Class C project for the Big Pine Indian Reservation;
- 3. On February 1, 1990, the Tribal Council adopted Resolution 90-02, extending its moratorium on septic systems from the northeast section of the Reservation to the entire Reservation;
- 4. The Tribe verbally agreed to state jurisdiction over its treated wastes, and on May 15, 1990, the Tribal Council adopted Resolution No. 90-21, agreeing to abide by the Regional Board's waste discharge requirements.
- 5. On April 12, 1990, by Resolution No. 6-90-31, the Lahontan Regional Water Quality Control Board approved the local moratorium and recommended the Reservation's entire project for inclusion on the SCG Priority List in Class A; and
- Division staff has reviewed the request and finds that it meets the requirements for placement on the SCG Priority List in Priority Class A.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE STATE BOARD:

Approves the addition of a Priority Class A project to the SCG Program Priority List for the Big Pine Indian Reservation, including the portion previously approved for funding in Priority Class C.
