RESOLUTION NO. 93-35

APPROVAL OF ADDITIONAL STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN FUNDING FOR THE
EAST BAY MUNICIPAL UTILITIES DISTRICT'S
CHEVRON WATER RECLAMATION PROJECT

WHEREAS:


1. The State Water Resources Control Board, on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities", and amended it on September 20, 1990 and on January 21, 1993;
2. The State Water Board, on September 17, 1992, adopted the FFY 1993 SRF Loan Program Priority List which includes the East Bay Municipal Utilities District's San Antonio Creek Wet Weather Treatment Facilities project;
3. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report, environmental documents, and revenue program for the EBMUD/Chevron Water Reclamation project; and
4. The information contained in the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) prepared for the project has been reviewed and considered (State Clearinghouse No. 88040518), and it has been determined that:
 - A. Changes or alterations have been required in, or incorporated into, the project which avoid or substantially lessen the potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the EIR with respect to the following aspects of the project: (i) biological impacts will be mitigated by using a minimum 100-foot buffer along San Pablo Creek, by using appropriate timing for pipeline placement, by avoiding marsh areas and by replanting with appropriate plant species; and (ii) water quality impacts will be mitigated by monitoring effluent, monitoring ground water extracted during dewatering and providing proper disposal when necessary, minimizing construction across creeks, and using erosion control measures.
 - B. With respect to the other potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the EIR, appropriate changes or alterations are within the responsibility and jurisdiction of other public agencies and such other changes or alterations have been adopted or can and should be adopted by such other agencies.
5. The State Water Board, on January 24, 1991, adopted a resolution approving a \$17.3 million SRF loan for the EBMUD/Chevron project.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board approve an additional \$4,919,399 in SRF loan funding for the EBMUD/Chevron Water Reclamation project.
