APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN FOR THE
STEGE SANITARY DISTRICT'S MOESER/STOCKTON RELIEF SEWER PROJECT
STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) PROJECT NO. C-06-4008-410

WHEREAS:


1. The State Water Resources Control Board, on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities", and amended it on September 20, 1990 and January 21, 1993;
2. The State Water Board, on September 17, 1992, adopted the FFY 1993 SRF Loan Program Priority List which did not include the Stege Sanitary Districts' Moeser/Stockton Relief Sewer project;
3. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report, environmental documents, and revenue program for the Moeser/Stockton Relief Sewer Project;
4. The Moeser/Stockton Relief Sewer project has a completed design and is ready to proceed to construction immediately upon State Water Board approval of SRF loan funding; and
5. The information contained in the Program EIR (State Clearinghouse No. 85110505) and Environmental Checklist (State Clearinghouse No. 93033027) prepared for the proposed project has been reviewed and considered, and it has been determined that changes or alterations have been required in, or incorporated into, the project which avoid or substantially lessen potentially significant environmental impacts identified in the EIR and Environmental Checklist. The appropriate changes or alterations are within the responsibility and jurisdiction of other public agencies and such other changes or alterations have been adopted or can and should be adopted by such other agencies.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The State Water Board add the Moeser/Stockton Relief Sewer project to the FFY 1993 SRF Project Priority List as a Priority Class B project, fundable in FFY 1993; and
2. The State Water Board approves a SRF loan of \$1.5 million for the Moeser/Stockton Relief Sewer Project, with a repayment period of twenty (20) years, and the first repayment due one (1) year after completion of construction.
