APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND (SRF) LOAN FOR
THE RUBIDOUX COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A REGIONAL PARALLEL TRUNK LINE
SRF PROJECT NO. C-06-4063-110

WHEREAS:


1. The State Water Board on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for the Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities", and amended it on September 20, 1990, and on January 21, 1993;
2. The State Water Board on September 17, 1992, adopted the Federal Fiscal Year 1993 SRF Loan Program Priority List which includes the Rubidoux Community Services District;
3. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report, environmental documents, and draft revenue program for the subject project; and
4. The Rubidoux Community Services District approved a Negative Declaration (State Clearinghouse No. 92012050) prepared for the project, which has been reviewed and considered and it has been determined that the project will not result in any significant environmental impacts.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. The State Water Board approves an SRF loan in the amount of \$3.2 million to the Rubidoux Community Services District for the construction of the regional parallel trunk line (SRF Project No. C-06-4063-110), with a repayment period of twenty (20) years, and the first annual loan repayment due one (1) year after the completion of construction; and
2. The Rubidoux Community Services District became a signatory to the "Memorandum of Understanding Regarding Urban Water Conservation in California (MOU)" on July 15, 1993 thereby satisfying the water conservation requirements of the State Water Resources Control Board's Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities (Policy).
