RESOLUTION NO. 93-109

APPROVAL OF A STATE REVOLVING FUND LOAN FOR THE
FAIRBANKS RANCH COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT
FAIRBANKS RANCH WATER POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY
ODOR CONTROL AND DENITRIFICATION PROJECT

WHEREAS:

1. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), on August 18, 1988, adopted the "Policy for Implementing the State Revolving Fund (SRF) for Construction of Wastewater Treatment Facilities" (Policy), and amended the Policy on September 20, 1990 and January 21, 1993;
2. The State Water Board, on September 23, 1993, adopted the Federal Fiscal Year 1994 State Revolving Fund Loan Program Priority List which includes the Fairbanks Ranch Water Pollution Control Facility Odor Control and Denitrification Project;
3. The Division of Clean Water Programs has approved the project report and the draft revenue program for this project; and
4. The Fairbanks Ranch Community Services District approved a Negative Declaration (State Clearinghouse No. 93041046) prepared for the project, which has been reviewed and considered and it has been determined that the project will not result in any significant environmental impacts.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Board approves a SRF loan of \$1.6 million for the Fairbanks Ranch Community Services District's Odor Control and Denitrification project, with a repayment period of twenty (20) years for the project and the first repayment due one (1) year after completion of construction.
