STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD RESOLUTION NO. 2004 - 0019

CONSIDERATION OF THE CENTRAL COAST REGIONAL WATER QUALITY CONTROL BOARD (CCRWQCB) REQUEST FOR FUNDING FROM THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL FUND CLEANUP AND ABATEMENT ACCOUNT (CAA) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$250,000 PURSUANT TO THE PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC (PG&E), MOSS LANDING POWER PLANT CONSENT JUDGMENT

WHEREAS:

- 1. In November 2002, the CCRWQCB filed an administrative civil liability action against PG&E which cited alleged violation of the National Pollutant Discharge System (NPDES) permits;
- 2. PG&E historically discharged billions of gallons of heated cooling water into Moss Landing Harbor in violation of its NPDES permits; and
- 3. The CCRWQCB and PG&E reached a settlement by which PG&E will pay the sum of \$250,000 to the State Water Resources Control Board to fund Supplemental Environmental Project oversight in the CCRWQCB.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The State Water Resources Control Board does hereby approve the Central Coast Regional Water Quality Control Board's request to use the \$250,000, received from the Pacific Gas and Electric consent judgment and deposited in the Cleanup and Abatement Account, to oversee Supplemental Environmental Projects specifically referenced in the consent judgment.
