Assembly Bill No. 411

CHAPTER 765

An act to amend Sections 115880, 115885, and 115915 of the Health and Safety Code, relating to public beaches.

AB 411, Wayne. Beach sanitation: posting.



# Bacteria TMDLs to Restore Beach Water Quality

Five Adopted TMDLs

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2002 ... 44 Santa Monica Bay beaches
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2003 ... Marina del Rey Harbor Mother's Beach and Back Basins (empties to SMB)

2004 ... Inner Cabrillo Beach, Los Angeles Harbor

2004 ... Malibu Creek and Lagoon (tributary to SMB)

2006 ... Ballona Creek and Estuary (tributary to SMB)

Upcoming TMDLs

2007 ... Ventura Harbor Beaches

#### Implementation of Bacteria TMDLs

- Comprehensive Shoreline Monitoring Plans
  - Additional monitoring points
  - Year-round monitoring
  - Shoreline monitoring moved to point of compliance = wave wash
- Implementation Plans
  - Incentive to use an Integrated Water
     Resources Approach = Longer implementation
     schedule

# Incorporation of TMDLs into Permits

- Summer Dry Weather WLAs incorporated into Los Angeles County MS4 permit
  - 2006 ... Santa Monica Bay beaches
  - 2007 ... Marina del Rey Harbor Mothers' Beach and Back Basins
- Method of Incorporation
  - Receiving Water Limits = Bact. Objectives for REC1
  - Prohibition on summer dry weather discharges from MS4 to receiving water that cause or contribute to an exceedance of the Receiving Water Limits

#### Implementation Deadlines

Summer Dry Weather Compliance deadlines

<u>July 15, 2006</u> - Santa Monica Bay beaches <u>April 1, 2007</u> - Marina del Rey Harbor Mothers' Beach

Upcoming April 1, 2010 - Inner Cabrillo Beach

#### Status of Compliance

- Majority of beaches < 5 exceedances during 2007 summer dry weather period
- 8 beaches > 5 days of exceedance
  - Santa Monica Beach: Santa Monica Pier & Pico-Kenter Storm Drain
  - Marina del Rey Harbor Mothers' Beach
  - Marie Canyon @ Puerco Beach
  - Castlerock Beach
  - Redondo Municipal Pier

#### Beaches at mouth of large freshwater creeks:

- Dockweiler Beach at Ballona Creek mouth
- Surfrider Beach at Malibu Creek mouth
- Topanga Beach at Topanga Creek mouth
