My water district has informed me that you intend to vote in the same restrictions you enacted last summer at your next meeting without actual figures of this year's rain and snowfall amounts. I have served on boards too and made decisions only when fully informed of the facts. Without this year's statistics, you lack full information upon which to base such a decision. I urge you to wait until you are fully informed about this year's rain and snowfall amounts before making a decision which adversely affects many homeowners and businesses which rely on water such as gardening supply businesses, house painters, concrete installers, and pool contractors to name but a few.
