Page 1, First Paragraph:

. . . San Luis & Delta-Mendota Water Authority and Westlands Water District. . .

Page 2, First Full Paragraph:

The discharge is also subject to the State Water Board's Water Quality Control Plan for the San Francisco Bay/Sacramento-San Joaquin Delta Estuary (Bay-Delta Plan; December 2006).

Page 5, Third Paragraph:

While the Stockton discharge occurs between the compliance locations described as interior Delta and southern Delta, it is physically much closer to the latter locations. The and we find that the Central Valley Water Board considered river morphology, river flows (including major diversions and tributaries), and in-stream and diverted uses of the water at the southern Delta (Brandt Bridge) compliance location and concluded that the river conditions that exist at the Facility discharge point are similar. We find that Board has properly applied the objectives for the southern Delta.

Page 8, Second Full Paragraph:

. . . adopted September 2 July 16, 2008, . . .
