Compliance Inspections	\$ 700,000	Inspections, Reports	51% of inspections.
Permitting	\$1,300,000	Draft Permit Preparation	46% of permits.
Stormwater Inspections	\$ 200,000	Inspections, Reports	37% of inspections (based upon SFY 07/08)
Federal NPDES Data System	\$ 720,000	Data Entry, Database Management	Manage CA data in Federal NPDES database (with SWRCB document management support)
Pretreatment	\$ 700,000	Inspections, Reports	100% of inspections.
TMDLs	\$ 400,000	Draft TMDL Preparation, Modeling, Monitoring	40% of the approved TMDLs received contractor technical assistance.
