He is a specialist on geographic information systems (GIS), cartographic visualization, and coastal watershed analysis. He has been a consultant to private industry and public agencies on a variety of mapping and geographic information systems projects. He has served on numerous boards and commissions including the San Diego County Planning Commission, the Otay Water District Board of Directors, the California County Planning Commissioners Association, the GIS/LIS National Steering Committee, and the Association of American Geographers National Council. He is also a current member of the Research Committee of the San Diego Museum of Natural History, the Research Committee of the Tijuana River National Estuarine Research Reserve, the Advisory Board of bd Systems, Inc., the International Geographic Information Foundation Board, the San Diego Oceans Foundation Board, and the Jamul-Dulzura Community Planning Group. Dr. Wright earned Bachelor and Master of Arts degrees from Indiana University, and a Doctor of Philosophy degree from the University of Kansas.






