Hello Martin,

Sorry for this last minute submittal. Don't worry it's short and the comments are minor.

1. Item 8 - My Solid Waste Permit lists the site at 617 acres (does not include buffer and recreation areas). Disposal area is the same as shown in your WDR - 286 acres.
2. Item 23 – Rumor has it that Vandenberg may be taking its waste to the new landfill. Can we add Vandenberg AFB to the list of potential waste contributors?
3. Item 66 – Can this be changed to read: “The Landfill is also regulated by the Santa Barbara County Environmental Health Services, which is designated as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) by the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle). The LEA issued a Solid Waste Facilities Permit No. 42-AA-0076 on May 30, 2012 with the concurrence of CalRecycle.”

Prohibitions

4. Item 8a – Is this requiring that all phases must be approved before any waste is discharged?
5. Item 8c – Seems to conflict with # 44 of the Order. Forty-four states that the operator has up to 3 years to install gas collection system.

Specifications

6. Item 28 – Please add “Santa Barbara County, Environmental Health Services/LEA” to your approval list.
