TRIENNIAL REVIEW OF THE WATER QUALITY CONTROL PLAN FOR
THE CENTRAL COASTAL BASIN

This Supplemental Sheet provides updated information for the Triennial Review Report, which is Attachment 2 to the Staff Report for Item 12. The Triennial Review Report includes a prioritized list of issues to be evaluated and potentially addressed through future Basin Plan amendments. Page 48 of the Triennial Review Report discusses the resources available to conduct these evaluations over the next three years. In this discussion of resources, the report incorrectly states that two personnel years will be available each year to work on the evaluations. While Central Coast Water Board staff has devoted two personnel years to basin planning annually, only one of these personnel years is available for the evaluations discussed in the Triennial Review Report. The other personnel year is used for assessment and planning related to groundwater protection, as well as program management. With one personnel year, rather than two, available for evaluation of the priority list of issues, staff estimates the first two to three highest priority issues will be evaluated over a three year period.

The second paragraph on page 48 of the Triennial Review Report is modified as follows:

| *Based on available Basin Planning resources of approximately ~~two~~one personnel per year (PY), staff anticipates that Central Coast Water Board staff can complete Basin Plan Issue*
| *Priorities 1 – ~~28~~ and start Basin Plan Issue Priority 3 within the next three years, if all*
resources are spent on the Priority Issues listed below.
