**DISCUSSION**

Board members and staff will tour several managed aquifer recharge facilities in the Watsonville area with staff of the Resource Conservation District of Santa Cruz County. See the figure in Item 11 for an aerial photograph of the general area.

We will first visit the site of a proposed infiltration project on ag land near Hwy 129 east of Watsonville, then we will visit the diversion for Pajaro Valley Water Management Agency's Harkins Slough project, and then from there to the recharge basin itself. RCD staff will accompany the visits and explain each project.
