ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION AND ORDER; JEFFREY ASHLOCK, GARDEN OAK ESTATES SUBDIVISION PROJECT (WDID NO. 5A04CR00309A1), BUTTE COUNTY

This Order responds to the 4 February 2021 request for an amendment of the Garden Oak Estates Subdivision Project Section 401 Water Quality Certification (WDID No. 5A04CR00309). The original Water Quality Certification (Certification) was issued on 28 April 2020. The requested amendment is hereby approved, and the original Certification is therefore amended as described below. Please attach this document to the original Certification.

AMENDMENT:

Jeffery Ashlock is requesting an amendment to the Section 401 Water Quality Certification and Order to change the required compensatory mitigation from Meridian Ranch Mitigation Bank to Colusa Basin Mitigation Bank. Therefore, Section XIV.K.2; Section XIV.K, Table 3; and Attachment B, Table 3 are amended in underline format below.

XIV.K Compensatory Mitigation for Permanent impacts:

2. Total Required Compensatory Mitigation

- **a.** The Permittee is required to provide compensatory mitigation for the authorized impact to 0.06 acre of canal by purchasing <u>0.09 credits of seasonal Wetland establishment credits at Colusa Basin Mitigation Bank.</u>
- **b.** The Permittee is required to provide compensatory mitigation for the authorized impact to 0.003 acre of ephemeral ditch by purchasing <u>0.004</u> <u>credits of seasonal wetland establishment credits at Colusa Basin</u> Mitigation Bank.
- **c.** The Permittee is required to provide compensatory mitigation for the authorized impact to 0.03 acre of vernal pool by purchasing <u>0.06 credits of seasonal wetland establishment credits at Colusa Basin Mitigation Bank.</u>

- **d.** The Permittee is required to provide compensatory mitigation for the authorized impact to 0.166 acre of wetland by purchasing <u>0.25 credits of seasonal wetland establishment credits at Colusa Basin Mitigation Bank.</u>
- **e.** Total required Project compensatory mitigation information for permanent physical loss of area is summarized in Table 3. [Establishment (Est.), Reestablishment (Re-est.), Rehabilitation (Reh.), Enhancement (Enh.), Preservation (Pres.), Unknown].
