ORDER AMENDING CLEAN WATER ACT SECTION 401 WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION AND ORDER; JUSTIN AND MADELINE JENSON, ADOBE ROAD BANK STABILIZATION – TAYLOR PROPERTY PROJECT (WDID NO. 5A52CR00201A1), TEHAMA COUNTY

Justin and Madeline Jenson are requesting an amendment to the Section 401 Water Quality Certification to change the mitigation bank credit type based on current availability. Therefore, Section XIV.K.2.a; Table 3; and Attachment B Tables 3 and 4 are amended in underline format below.

- **XIV.K.2. Total Required Compensatory Mitigation**
 - a. The Permittee is required to provide compensatory mitigation for the authorized impact to 0.014 acre of stream channel by purchasing 0.014 acre of Riparian Floodplain Forest Habitat restoration credits from the Fremont Landing Conservation Bank.

- b. Total required Project compensatory mitigation information for permanent physical loss of area is summarized in Table 3. [Establishment (Est.), Re-establishment (Re-est.), Rehabilitation (Reh.), Enhancement (Enh.), Preservation (Pres.), Unknown].
