TRANSMITTAL OF ORDER RESCINDING WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS, WOODSIDE HOME OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA, LP, WOODWARD ESTATES, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY

On 27 April 2016, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the State Water Resources Control Board's *Statewide General Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges to Land with a Low Threat to Water Quality* (Order 2003-003-DWQ) to Woodside Homes of Northern California, LP, for discharges to land from construction dewatering for the Woodward Estates project.

Your Notice of Termination, dated 3 February 2020, states that discharges from the project ceased on 30 June 2016, the project was completed in November 2016, and you wish to terminate coverage under the General Waste Discharge Requirements. Based on that information, coverage under Order 2003-003-DWQ-0149 is hereby rescinded.
