On 22 November 2011, the Executive Officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability under Order No. R5-2008-0149, *In-Situ Groundwater Remediation at Sites with Volatile Organic Compounds, Nitrogen Compounds, Perchlorate, Pesticides, Semi-Volatile Compounds, Hexavalent Chromium and/or Petroleum Hydrocarbons*. In the Notice of Applicability the project was assigned site-specific Order No. R52008-0149-034.

Remediation was conducted under this project from 12 December 2011 to 16 December 2011 and included injection of a total of 6,336 gallons of a 17 percent by weight solution of sodium persulfate into the groundwater at five locations. Post injection monitoring was conducted through October 2013, unacceptable impact to secondary water quality parameters was not observed during or after pilot testing.

You requested termination of coverage for the Project in the October 2013 Monitoring Results Report dated 19 November 2013. Therefore, through this letter, General Order No. R5-2008-0149-034 is hereby terminated as of the date of this letter. Invoicing for General Order coverage will be modified accordingly.
