**RESCISSION OF COVERAGE UNDER CONDITIONAL WAIVER OF WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR SMALL FOOD PROCESSORS AND SMALL WINERIES WITHIN THE CENTRAL VALLEY REGION, BLACKVETTE WINERY, PLACER COUNTY**

On 01 July 2020, the Executive officer of the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a Notice of Applicability granting coverage under the *Conditional Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirements for Small Food Processors, Wineries, and Related Agricultural Processors within the Central Valley Region*, Order R5-2020-0002 (the Waiver). You were assigned Order R5-2020-0002-0006.

On 04 March 2021 we received your letter informing us of the closure of your facility, and request for termination of coverage under R5-2020-0002. You state that the winery is closed and you will no longer produce wine at this location. Based on this information, Order R5-2020-0002-0006 is hereby rescinded.
