(National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit No. CA0078930),
for

CITY OF BIGGS
WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT
BUTTE COUNTY

The City of Biggs (Discharger) owns and operates a wastewater treatment plant (Facility) in the City of Biggs, Butte County. The wastewater treatment system consists of two aerated lagoons, a ballast pond, three plug flow rock filters in parallel, and chlorination/dechlorination facilities. The Facility discharges treated effluent to Lateral K, a constructed agricultural drainage channel. The discharge from the Facility is currently regulated pursuant to Waste Discharge Requirements Order No. 5-00-255 and National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Permit No. CA0078930. The Discharger submitted a Report of Waste Discharge and applied for a NPDES permit renewal to continue discharging up to 0.38 million gallons per day (mgd) of treated wastewater from the Facility to Lateral K.

A public hearing concerning this matter will be held during the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board (Regional Board) meeting, which is scheduled for:

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Regional Board no later than **5 April 2007**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item must submit evidence and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **5 April 2007**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **5 April 2007** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record, unless the Regional Board agrees to accept the evidence or comments and if doing so would not prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross-examination will be limited in time by the Regional Board Chair.
