The Jamestown Mine is an inactive gold mine in Tuolumne County that operated from 1986 to 1994. The Jamestown Trust I through its trustee (operator), and County of Tuolumne, Robert Cameron and Gary Wilson currently own the Jamestown Mine (jointly Dischargers). The principal features of the mine are: the three mine pits (including Harvard Mine Pit), the Tailings Management Facility (TMF), and the Process Water Retention Pond (PWRP). These Waste Discharge Requirements regulate the closure and post-closure of the TMF; and operation and maintenance of the PWRP and Harvard Mine Pit.

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Board no later than **24 May 2007**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, and/or comments in writing to the Regional Board no later than **24 May 2007**. Written evidence or comments submitted after **24 May 2007** will not be

accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.
