**PUBLIC HEARING**

Tentative Time Schedule Order  
for

**MARLEY COOLING TOWER COMPANY  
GROUNDWATER TREATMENT PLANT  
SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY**

Marley Cooling Tower Company (MCTC), a subsidiary of SPX Corporation (hereafter together referred to as Discharger), owns and operates a groundwater treatment plant located at the MCTC's former Stockton facility. The Discharger is currently regulated by Order No. R5-2003-0030 (existing NPDES permit). Water Board staff determined that a time schedule for compliance with final effluent limitations for total dissolved solids (TDS) must be in an enforcement Order. The proposed Time Schedule Order requires full compliance with the TDS effluent limitation by 1 February 2012; it includes a requirement to develop and implement a pollution prevention plan for TDS; and it includes an interim limitation for TDS.

The designated parties for this hearing are as follows:

Only designated parties will have these rights: to call and examine witnesses; to introduce exhibits; to cross-examine opposing witnesses; to impeach any witness; and to rebut the evidence against him or her. All other persons wishing to testify or provide comments are interested persons and not designated parties. Such interested persons may request status as a designated party for purposes of this hearing by submitting such request in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than **18 January 2008**. The request must explain the basis for status as a designated party and in particular how the person is directly affected by the discharge.

Persons wishing to comment on this noticed hearing item shall submit testimony, evidence, if any, or comments in writing to the Regional Water Board no later than by noon on **18 January 2008**. Written evidence or comments submitted after noon on **18 January 2008** will not be accepted and will not be incorporated into the administrative record if doing so would prejudice any party.

All designated parties and interested persons may speak at the Regional Water Board meeting, and are expected to orally summarize their written submittals. Oral testimony and cross examination will be limited in time by the Board Chair.
